I work on several different projects simultaneously in Xcode 4. This is sometimes inconvenient, because I need to open several separate windows to debug code. Is there any way to configure Xcode so that I can run all debuggers for different projects at the same time? The reason for the question is that I run hundreds of different projects in an automated build process, and I want to be able to use all the available debuggers when I need to work on a particular project. A: I think you can now configure multiple breakpoints in a project. This will enable you to run multiple instances of Xcode simultaneously. A: I do this by putting each project in a separate workspace, and setting the "Breakpoints" property in each project to "Unset."
