Can this be accomplished with either jquery or javascript? A: jQuery doesn't have this sort of functionality, but some kind of Javascript will do. For example: `document.getElementsByName("formname")[0].disabled = true;` [formname] would be the form's

name attribute value. Of course, be sure to check for the existence of the form before trying to access it - if the form is disabled, this code will throw an error. Q: Combine.c files Hello I am trying to create a class in C# using the dot net framework, I have created a class in visual studio, and I have created a.h and.c file for it, for some reason I cannot get my.h file to recognize the.c file. Below is what I am currently getting in Visual studio. I can't figure out what I am doing wrong, I am very new to C# and this is my first time using the dot net framework. Any help is greatly

appreciated. A: When you create your header file (.h) file, you have to create the header that will be used by the.c file. Something like this: `extern "C" { class Foo { void Bar(); } }` It will create a C like extern class that will get the variable Foo declared in your.h file to the.c file. Then in your.c file you have to do something like this: `#include "Foo.h" void Foo::Bar() { }` Also make sure the.c file is a C file, not a C++ file.
