Later, MOOC-ABC was joined by more than 40 other European universities in the MOOC-ABC-plus initiative, which is managed by European Research Council. The 2010 U.S. Census Bureau Annual Survey of Public School Teachers found that in most states, 25 percent of public school teachers are women. In 2012, there were approximately 3.4 million people in the United States, between the ages of 16 and 24, who were enrolled in full-time higher education and out of those only 15 percent were female. In September 2009, Free Raccoon announced the completion of an agreement with Higher One, Inc., a provider of online financial services, to offer its course in partnership with Higher One. The American Association of Community Colleges offers a doctoral, Master of Arts, and a bachelor's degree online.
